In collaboration with Hui Mālama Ola Nā 'Ōiwi, Bay Clinic provides diabetes screening, nutrition education and counseling, blood pressure screening, physical exams to Native Hawaiians in east Hawai'i. Sixty percent of Bay Clinic's patients require case management services.

**Services**—CCM provides a comprehensive range of health services for all life cycles: perinatal services, family planning, pediatric, general and family practice medicine, and internal medicine. Urgent care is provided as is preventive medicine, patient education, and nutritional services. Behavioral health services include counseling and treatment for chemical dependency and mental health issues, including crisis and short-term counseling, group therapy and case management. Interpreter services are available in Tagalog, Ilocano, and Spanish. WIC (Women Infant and Children Supplemental Food Program) is offered onsite. CCM also provides Tobacco Cessation Services. CCM participates in the County Ice Program and the Diabetes Collaborative and has agreements with Hui No Ke Ola Pono (Maui's Native Hawaiian Health Care System), Aloha House, Salvation Army, and the Maui Family Recovery Center.

**Services**—HCHC provides the full range of primary care services including medical and dental care, well-child care, routine immunizations, women's health care, treatment for common health problems, chronic disease management, mental/behavioral health problems and traditional healing services including *lomilomi* therapy. All services including x-rays, laboratory and pre-packaged medications are provided on a sliding fee scale base on household size and income. HCHC's physicians provide urgent care services 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Although not an emergency room, HCHC works in cooperation with American Medical Response and Maui Memorial Medical Center to stabilize and transport patients with emergent medical conditions.

**Services**—KPHC provides services in general medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, family planning, health education, WIC nutrition, dental and optometry programs, case management, and behavioral/mental health. KPHC staff is able to serve patients in multiple languages including Ilocano, Tagalog, Vietnamese, Chinese, Korean, Samoan, Spanish, Laotian, Tongan, Chukkese, Pohnpeian and Kosraean. It has partnered with the Institute of Human Services and River of Life Mission to deliver health care to the area's large homeless population, and with WIC to provide breastfeeding and nutrition counseling with food coupons. KPHC is an education site for the University of Hawai'i's Schools of Nursing, Medicine, and Social Work. It also collaborates on community research projects with other health centers and the Association of Asian and Pacific Community Health Organizations (AAPCHO).

**Services**—WHC provides the following medical care and outreach services:

- **Primary Care Medical Clinic**—offering primary medical care without regard to a person's ability to pay. Includes care for chronic and acute conditions, family planning, pharmaceutical and lab services, immunizations and other care typically offered in general medical clinics.
- **Care-A-Van**—bringing health and social services to the homeless in parks, beaches, or on the streets through medically equipped, professionally staffed vans.
- **Youth Outreach Project**—Providing care to runaway, throwaway, and homeless youth through a drop-in center and adolescent clinic. Open three days a week, this is a collaborative project with Hale Kipa Youth Services.
- **Ho'ōla Like**—three satellite clinics serve North Shore and Windward communities with primary medical care, traditional Native Hawaiian healing, and community outreach.

- **STD/HIV Services**—full range of treatment and wellness services for persons infected with HIV. Prevention education including: statewide hotline (922-1313) for information about HIV and other sexually transmitted diseases, and free and anonymous counseling and testing.
- **Native Hawaiian Healing**—providing culturally appropriate Native Hawaiian healing practices including *lomilomi*, *ho'oponopono*, and *lā'au lapa'au*.

HLH has an asthma and tobacco cessation program located in Līhu'e that provides services island-wide. **Services Provided**—Hui Mālama focuses on providing preventive health services. Staff provides health education and outreach and transportation to and from treatment. Care managers provide assistance in getting health insurance, medications, scheduling doctor appointments and routine health maintenance. Hui Mālama does screenings for prostate, breast, and cervical cancer; cholesterol; high blood pressure; and diabetes; and promotes colo-rectal education and testing. Prenatal classes and referrals are also available. A nutritionist provides diet and nutrition counseling.

- Native Hawaiian Traditional Healing (*lomilomi, ho'oponopono*)
- Nutritional Education and Counseling (Mea'ai Pono and Hele Mai'ai teach participants to healthy diet modifications including eating the traditional Hawaiian diet)
- Simply Healthy Café (serves healthy lunches)
- Case management (individualized counseling to improve health and referral to other needed services)
- Wellness Classes and Programs (covering such health concerns as diabetes, hypertension, asthma, exercise, breast cervical cancer, health monitoring)
- Community Health Screenings (blood pressure, blood sugar, cholesterol, otitis media)
- Perinatal classes (nutrition and exercise during and after pregnancy, preparing for delivery, breast feeding, caring for babies from birth to 18 months, gestational diabetes, child-proofing the home)
- School-Based Oral Health Program—education; proper brushing and flossing; nutrition; oral health assessment/treatment for pre-schools, MEO Head Start, Kamehameha Schools, Waihe'e and Hāna High and Elementary Schools

**Services**—Ke Ola Mamo focuses on health promotion, health prevention, client assessment, enrollment, referral case management, transportation to and from physician visits and other enabling services.

Outreach services are provided at the various sites. Clients are enrolled and assessed to determine health needs, which may include assistance with obtaining health insurance, referrals to Native Hawaiian practitioners, case management, transportation to and from physician visits and other enabling services. Staff conducts health education, promotion and prevention services through community based health fairs, clubs, organizations and civic groups, individuals and families especially among high-risk groups, island-wide. The outreach team also assists with collaborative case management under the supervision of the clinical team.

Clinical services are provided by Registered Nurses. Services include: intense case management and monitoring of patient care plans; screening for glucose, total cholesterol, HDL, LDL, triglyceride; blood pressure; home visits, and appropriate referrals. The nurses also provide a higher level of health education on diabetes, cancer, and cardiovascular disease among high-risk populations.



Health education is conducted, in groups or one-on-one, by clinical staff and outreach workers. Topics covered include: traditional healing, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, smoking cessation, asthma classes, cancer (breast/cervical), HIV/STD education, car seat safety, domestic violence, parenting skills, stress reduction, immunizations, nutrition (Hele Mai 'Ai), breast-feeding, fitness, pre-natal/child development, maternal fetal development, dental, safety and injury prevention.
